- 19/22/6 Chairs report on crime trends in Handforth: In brief: Crime incidents continue to increase - 20% up compared to 2018, virtually double the 2016 rate. Relative to neighbouring areas, Handforth crime is now much higher - nearly two-thirds higher. The clear-up (conviction) rate has slumped dramatically - now only 1.6%. The chair has written again to the Police Commissioner requesting action.
