I propose a vote of thanks to Councillor Brian Tolver for his work on the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). Cheshire East Council (CEC) had

proposed that Handforth should receive NO funds from the housing development on the Garden Village at Handforth. But over the last two years Councillor Tolver has accumulated a mass of evidence about house values in the region and presented this to the Independent Examiner who ruled on CEC's proposals. The Examiner concluded "I agree with representors that [CEC] has underestimated likely sales values that might be expected ..." and recommended the same level of CIL be used for Handforth as the highest level in Cheshire East. As a result, Handforth will receive in the order of £2.5 million over the next ten years to improve its infrastructure. As a consequence of his efforts on behalf of Handforth and the Council I propose a special thanks to him for his sterling work on behalf of the community. Cllr Thompson.
